PRESENTATION:

Established at Louvain-la-Neuve in 1991 by the Fédération Internationale des Instituts d'Études Médiévales (FIDEM), the European Diploma in Medieval Studies (DEEM) provides advanced academic training for students and scholars specialising in Medieval Studies. The programme is renowned by its methodological and practical approach to disciplines related to manuscripts and their auxiliary sciences. This specialised training is delivered through the expertise of leading scholars in each discipline and in collaboration with key institutions, such as Sapienza University of Rome (SARAS Department) and SIEPM (Société Internationale pour l'Étude de la Philosophie Médiévale).

From the 2024 academic year, the DEEM program will be offered in an updated format, running from mid-January to the end of May. The core disciplines of Classical Latin, Medieval Latin, Palaeography, Codicology, Diplomatics, and Textual Editing will be complemented by two new modules in Digital Scholarly Editing. All classes will be conducted in English beginning on Monday, 13th January 2025. All courses will take place in Rome at the Norwegian Institute (<https://www.hf.uio.no/dnir/english/>) with options for partial online attendance. The mandatory in-person participation offers a unique opportunity to explore Rome's remarkable manuscript collections through included library visits.

A minimum of 6 participants is required for the course to take place. Participants may choose from full DEEM participation, modular participation, and personalized attendance. For enrolment fees and available participation options, please visit: <https://fidemweb.org/deem-application/>.
