Title:

Time and the future in Southeast Asia

Short description:

This lecture is about Southeast Asian perceptions of time and the future, and how these have changed in the last 100 years or so. Broadly speaking, cyclic and fatalistic understandings of time, associated with beliefs in fortune-telling and prophecy, have given way to an idea of the future as amenable to human direction. This does not mean, however, that religion and prayer have been replaced by science and reason. On the contrary, modernization in Southeast Asia has been accompanied by religious revival, perhaps partly because modernity brings with it new types of uncertainty about the future.
